SERMON OUTLINE

“Jesus In The Garden”

Matthew 26: 36-46

Introduction: The agony of Christ began in the Garden of Gethsemane.

- I. Jesus experienced tremendous grief in the Garden. (Matthew 26: 38)
 - A. The grief of rejection. (Jn. 1:11, Isa 53:3)
 - B. The grief of betrayal. (Matt. 26: 45-49)
 - C. The grief of separation from God the Father. (Matthew 27:46, Isa. 53:6)
 - D. The grief of our sorrows. (Isa. 53:4, Luke 22:44)
- II. Being in agony, he prayed. (Matt. 26:39)
 - A. Jesus prayed constantly. (Mark 1:35)
 - B. He prayed earnestly. (Luke 22:44, Jer. 29:13)
 - C. He prayed persistently. (Matt. 26: 44)
- III. Jesus called for prayer partners. (Matt. 26: 38)
 - A. Jesus needed others to pray “with him.” (Matt. 26: 38,40)
 - B. The disciples needed to pray. (Matt. 26: 41)
- IV. Jesus won the victory in the Garden. (Matt 26:39)
 - A. To win is to choose God’s will above our own. (Isa. 53:10-12)
 - B. Jesus overcame the last temptation. (Matt. 27:40)

Conclusion: Join Jesus in the Garden. Let him carry away your griefs and sorrows and win the victory through surrender
